





Microbial Fuel Cell Competition 2023-24

Brief Overview

Junior high and senior high classes (Grade 7-12) are invited to participate in a multi-classroom competition to build the most effective fuel cell powered by microbes. Participating classes will present their findings and be eligible for various prizes.

Steps to Participate

(1) Initial Application (Deadline: December 15, 2023)

Write an email to gideonchoi@10peaks.ca indicating the class(es) that you would like to sign up, and the reason you are interested in participating. Classes must be Grade 7-12 and located in Alberta. Classes that qualify will be loaned a classroom kit of MudWatts (10 units) to be used for the competition. Be sure to act quickly because only 6 class sets are available.

(2) Class experiments (Deadline: April 30, 2024)

Follow the MudWatt building instructions that come with the kits. Your class will also complete three activities, and a written submission will be part of your findings. The class submission will be assessed on the ability to write clearly and communicate well.

- Measuring Current and Voltage of a MudWatt
- What Makes Up Soil

(3) Competition (Mid-late May, date TBD)

Participating classes will meet virtually to present to a panel of judges. Classes will present on what they learned in how to optimize microbial fuel cell performance. Prizes will be awarded for best performing MudWatts, best written submissions, and best presentations.
